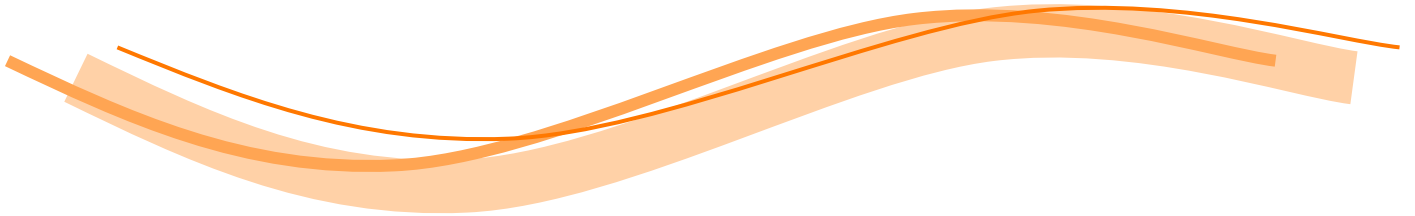

**Day 4: CULLODEN BATTLEFIELD & SHEEPDOG TRIALS**

A short distance from Nairn is the Culloden Battlefield Visitor Centre where the British Government forces defeated the army of Prince Charles Edward Stuart, popularly named Bonnie Prince Charlie. Walk around the moorland and the Visitor Centre which explains how events led to the conflict ending the clan system in Scotland. Continue through majestic Highland scenery to a local farm for a demonstration of trained dogs herding sheep. Travel through the high peaks of the Grampian Mountains to your gracious manor-style hotel near Pitlochry.

**Day 5: BLAIR CASTLE & WHISKY TASTING**

Visit Blair Castle, home of the Dukes and Earls of Atholl.
