Location: In the heart of SE Asia, total of 13 states and 3 Federal Territories which are separated by the South China Sea with 11 states and 2 Federal territories (Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya) in Peninsular Malaysia and 2 states with 1 Federal territory (Labuan) in East Malaysia (Borneo).

Population: 28.3 million.

Major Ethnicities: Malay, Chinese, Indian.

Religion: Although Islam is Malaysia's official religion many religions are freely practiced.

Language: Malay is the national language, but English is also prevalent.

Climate: Soothing tropical weather, ranging from 70 - 90 degrees Fahrenheit year-round.

Entry Requirements: Passports with minimum 6 months' validity needed. Visas depend on country of citizenship.
